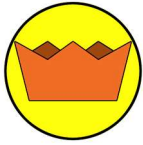

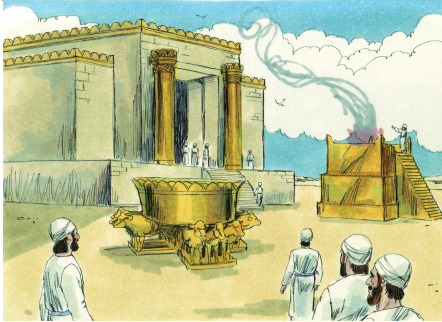

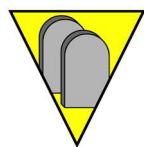

7 Blessing

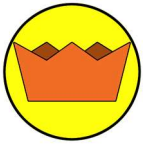
